We are excited to bring back this Scholarship opportunity last offered in 2019. Below are the minimum requirements and highly encourage high school seniors to apply.

Minimum Eligibility Requirements:

- Worked as a referee, scorekeeper or volunteer for MCAA in this year's season (winter or spring 2025 season).
- Must be a Hawaii high school senior graduating this year (2025).
- Must have a minimum and current 3.0 GPA with proof of transcript from your high school.
- Must write a 1-2 page essay about MCAA (see below for subject matter).
- Must be attending a next level educational institution (proof of enrollment).

Essay Subject Matter:

Your essay should be about MCAA and how it has benefited you and the community. You should interview and provide feedback and comments from players, coaches, and spectators on what MCAA means to them and what it has provided for their child, not just in sports but in other life skill areas as well. Provide details on what you have learned from working or volunteering with this organization, and include your experience if you also played with MCAA as a young child.

Scholarship Donation Amount & Deadline:
