Coach's Code of Conduct

I hereby recognize that it is a privilege to participate in the Mililani Community Athletic Association (MCAA) program and therefore agree to abide by the following:

1. This league is for the kids and its intent is to provide a positive, sportsmanlike experience for all the kids as stated in the League Philosophy below.
2. I will place the emotional/physical well-being of all players and participants ahead of any personal desire to win.
3. I will ensure that my conduct as a participant in the MCAA program, both at and around the playing or practice site(s), is in line with this Code of Conduct and the League Philosophy.
4. Absolutely no profanity will be tolerated within the MCAA program by coaches, parents, players, and others including spectators.
5. Under no circumstances will verbal abuse or other harassment be directed toward league representatives, referees, game officials, coaches, players, opponents, spectators, etc. Such actions may result in a technical foul and that person will be required to leave the premises.
6. No smoking, vaping, consumption of alcoholic beverages, or use of illegal or dangerous narcotics or drugs will be permitted during practice sessions, games, or activities of the MCAA. Such actions will result in an automatic and immediate termination from all program participation.
7. Any violations of the Code of Conduct during MCAA activities will result in my removal from the premises.
8. I agree to abide by whatever decision(s)/action(s) the MCAA Board may take if I violate any of these Code of Conduct rules.

As a coach, I also agree to:

1. Do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging for all my players.
2. Do my best to provide a safe play situation for all players, and not allow any fighting among players during practice(s) or game(s).
3. Do my best to administer first aid to injured players to the best of my knowledge and if needed, to contact proper emergency help.
4. Lead by example, demonstrating fair play and good sportsmanship to all my players.
5. Ensure that I am knowledgeable in the league's basketball rules, and that I will teach these rules to my players.
6. Use the coaching techniques appropriate for each of the skills that I teach.
